About the Fellowship

The programme will bring about 15 journalists from across Asia to Singapore for three months. Fellows pursue their intellectual interests through their independent research projects, attend seminars, and engage with key newsmakers in Singapore. The Fellowship is a joint initiative of Temasek Foundation International and the Institute of Policy Studies, which is part of the Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy at the National University of Singapore www.ajf.sg).

Tell us about the applicant

Your reference letter should comment on the impact that the applicant has already made, and his/her potential to make a difference to his/her profession and society in future. Please describe his/her special abilities as a journalist as well as unique personal qualities that make him/her an outstanding individual.

How to send your letter

You may pass your letter to the applicant to include in his/her application, or e-mail it directly to <u>applications@ajf.sg</u>. In the "Subject" field of your e-mail, type "Recommendation Letter for (Full name of the applicant)".

Deadline

Applications will be considered only if all materials, including recommendation letters, are received by the end of Sunday, 9 April 2017 (Singapore time).
